Thursday, 28 August

A short afternoon run to the Wilkins Cider Farm, Lands' End Farm, Mudgley, Wedmore BS28 4TU (www.wilkinscider.com). Cider is made in the traditional way at Roger Wilkins' eccentric and remote Somerset farm. Unlimited tastings are available and a range of ciders and local cheeses are available to buy - 4.6-mile return trip.

Evening BBQ - Bring your own meat and drink and we will provide the BBQ.

Friday 29th August

Breakfast available in the Tea Room.

We visit the world's oldest prison in Shepton Mallet (Frithfield Lane, Shepton Mallet BA4 5FQ - www.sheptonmalletprison.com). The prison opened in 1625 and closed in 2013. In recent years it has seen much use as a film location for a variety of productions including Paddington 2, Des and Grantchester. Probably its most famous inmates were the Kray brothers. We are booked on a 90-minute guided tour starting at 11.45. There is souvenir shop and cafe on site. The discounted group entry charge, including the tour, is £18 and we will be able to park our cars within the prison walls by special arrangement. After we finish the prison visit we are welcome to leave our cars parked there and walk around Shepton Mallet before returning to the rally site - 29-mile round trip.

The Tea Room and Bar will stay open until late for our use,

Saturday 30th August.

There will be a chance to visit to Partsmart in Cheddar for those wishing to do so. We will visit the world's largest helicopter museum at Weston-Super-Mare (Locking Moor Rd, Weston-Super-Mare BS24 8PP - https://helimuseum.com). The award-winning Helicopter Museum holds over 100 Rotary wing aircraft gathered from all over the world representing a wide spectrum of technologies. The museum also features a cafe. The discounted entry charge is £12 or £10 for seniors. Our Schmitt's will be on displayed to the public in a special parking area - 32-mile round trip.

The Tea Room and Bar will stay open until late for our use.

This will be a chance to celebrate the KR200's 70th.
