Thursday, 30 July

Make your way to the beautiful Cumbria area. Pitch up, get the kettle on and settle into the rally site. Maybe take a walk into Maryport for some liquid sustenance and a bite to eat.

Early arrivals are possible on the Wednesday evening and late departures on the Monday morning. Please book via Dennis Shaw.

Friday 31st July

Today's road run will take us up the Solway coastal road with brilliant views looking out to Scotland to the Victorian seaside town of Silloth. Lots to see and do here as well as lots of places to eat which are reasonably priced. We will then progress on to Abbeytown and visit Holmcultram Abbey. Our final destination will be a visit to a large private collection of some 22 Messerschmitt's and other interesting vintage and classic vehicles. Refreshments will be provided at this stopping point.

Back on site we will have a welcome reception with drinks and nibbles to celebrate the club's 70th Anniversary.

The bar will be open and pre ordered fish and chips will be delivered around 7pm

Saturday 1st August.

Today's road run will see a slightly longer and more challenging run into the more scenic parts of the Lake district. We will pass through Cockermouth and on to Bassenthwaite passing the first lake and on to Keswick. We will pass by Derwent water stopping to take in the views. Those who want a challenge can progress to the lunchtime stop at Buttermere via the Honister pass. A spectacular drive with some **1 in 4 sections**. The rest of the group will travel the slightly longer distance to Buttermere via Braithwaite and High Lorton. We will then return to site via Lorton vale passing through Cockermouth again but on a different route.

A prebooked 3 Course evening meal at Redby's Restaurant will be available to all.

Sunday, 2nd August

Sunday will be the traditional show day. We will be holding the now established auction and welcome items to be sold. Club concours and prize giving.
